Develle made the motion to approve the December 10, 2024, meeting minutes. Tamiko 2nd. Motion passed Unanimously.

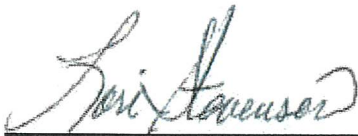

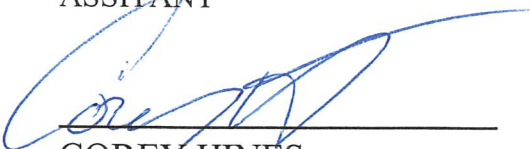
The Kennedale City Council reserves the rights to meet in Executive (Closed) Session at any time during the meeting pursuant to the below cited sections of the Texas Government Code.
