If a Closed or Executive Session is held in accordance with the Texas Government Code as set out above, the Kennedale City Council will reconvene in Open Session in order to take action, if necessary, on the items addressed during Executive Session.

RESOLUTION #650

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KENNEDALE, TEXAS, DESIGNATING MAYOR BRIAN JOHNSON, TO SERVE AS THE CITY'S VOTING REPRESENTATIVE AT THE NCTCOG'S ANNUAL, REGULAR, OR SPECIAL GENERAL ASSEMBLY MEETINGS IN 2026 AND 2027 UNTIL JANUARY 1, 2028; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of KENNEDALE, Texas ("City"), is a home rule city acting under its charter adopted by the electorate pursuant to Article XI, Section 5 of the Texas Constitution and Chapter 9 of the Local Government Code; and

WHEREAS, the City is a member of the North Central Texas Council of Governments ("NCTCOG") and entitled to vote at NCTCOG General Assembly meetings; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to appoint a member of the City Council to be the City's voting representative at the NCTCOG's annual, regular, or special General Assembly meetings in 2026 and 2027, including but not limited to the annual 2026 and 2027 NCTCOG General Assembly meetings; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes Mayor Brian Johnson, is an elected or appointed official of the City Council and meets the eligibility requirements to serve as the City's voting representative for NCTCOG;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KENNEDALE, TEXAS THAT:

SECTION 1

The City of Kennedale hereby designates Mayor, Brian Johnson, to serve as the City's voting representative at the NCTCOG's annual, regular, or special General Assembly meetings or meetings of the NCTCOG members in 2026 and 2027, including but not limited to the 2026 and 2027 NCTCOG General Assembly meetings beginning the date of this resolution until January 1, 2028. The City Council may revoke and rescind this designation at any time. The City Manager or designee may complete and execute on behalf of the City any necessary forms from NCTCOG listing the designee named above as the City's voting representative.

SECTION 2

This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.

Background

- **The North Central Texas Council of Government (NCTCOG) 2026 general assembly meeting will be held on June 12, 2026, at the Hurst Conference Center at noon.**
- **The City has been notified by NCTCOG that voting for members will be slightly different than in past years.**
- **The City is a member of the NCTCOG and entitled to vote at the NCTCOG's general assembly meetings.**
- **According to NCTCOG, each local government member is entitled to one voting representative at general assembly meetings.**
 - **The City does not have a representative established to vote on behalf of the City at NCTCOG general assembly meetings.**
- **The agenda item before the City Council for consideration is a resolution requesting the appointment or designation of an individual to serve as the City's voting representative at the NCTCOG general assembly meeting.**
- **To serve, the City's designated representative 1) must be physically present at the general assembly and 2) must be an elected or appointed official serving on the City Council. (City staff members are not eligible to serve as a voting representative.)**
 - **The proposed resolution before the City Council seeks to designate an individual to serve as the City's voting representative at all NCTCOG general assembly meetings or other meetings of the members in the calendar years of 2026 and 2027, not just the one meeting called on June 12, 2026.**
- **The proposed resolution designates an individual to serve as the voting representative until January 1, 2028. The resolution also specifies that the City Council may rescind the designation at any time.**

Under the Bylaws of the North Central Texas Council of Governments, each member government that is current on dues is entitled to one voting representative at the General Assembly. The voting representative must be an elected or appointed official from the governing body of the member government. Staff persons are NOT eligible.

This form must be completed to be eligible to vote at the 2026 General Assembly meeting on June 12, 2026, at the Hurst Conference Center. THE DESIGNATED VOTING REPRESENTATIVE MUST BE PHYSICALLY PRESENT AT THE MEETING TO CAST THEIR VOTE(S). IN THE EVENT OF MULTIPLE DESIGNATION FORMS FOR THE SAME ENTITY, THE REPRESENTATIVES PRESENT MUST AGREE WHO THE VOTING REPRESENTATIVE IS FOR THE ENTITY'S VOTE(S) TO BE COUNTED.
