KEEP KENNEDALE BEAUTIFUL COMMISSION MINUTES

I. CALL TO ORDER

II. WORK SESSION

A. WORK SESSION REPORTS

1. Texas Trash Off/Don't Mess with Texas, April 15, 2023.

The KKB Texas Trash off event will be on Saturday April 15, 2023. Volunteers will meet at 9:00 am in Town Center Park. The Public Works department will be there to distribute bottles of water to all the volunteers.

2. Adopt-a-Spot Updates

Brad Horton chose the area near Public Works for his adopt-a-spot location because it is safer for his children. Kim thanked Public Works for putting up the KKB Commissioner sign for their Adopt-a-Spot located at the City Entrance sign on N. Little School Rd.

3. Mayor's Monarch Pledge.

The Mayor's Monarch Pledge is up and running, you can go to the nwf.org/ National Wild Life Federation and see it.

Kim will email the Mayor to issue her own proclamation. Laurie stated the secretary would print the proclamation and have the Mayor sign it. Kim will email Raeanne and the Mayor to remind them about the proclamation.

4. Budget Report

KKB will request a current budget report from the finance department next month.

5. Volunteer Hours and Activities

Volunteer 108 hours in March. Kim did two webinars; the native and pollinator of North Texas was under the Tarrant County Master Gardener presentation and the monarch preservation habitat was from T.R.W.D.

6. New Business

Kim bought some new Silver Dragons to replace the ones that died in the circle. Stegall's nursery will be closing in a month and KKB needs an alternate place to purchase plants, because Site One does not have the bedding plants that Kim wants. Kim wanted to revisit the option of having more business to shop. The City Manager wants vendors from within the City. Kim asked about advertising Bring It on the water bill. The finance director will be the contact for any information going onto the water bill. KKB would like to purchase new gardening tools, ant killers and fertilizer. Kim will provide a list of items needed.

2. Discussion and consideration about being a vendor at the Bark in the Park event on May 20, 2023 from 9am - 12pm.

Kid Fish/ Bark in the Park are two separate events that happen on the same day. Kid Fish is from 8 am to 12 noon. Bark in the Park is from 9 am to 12 noon. Kim spoke with Silva from the Police Department. All vendors must be dog-related. Laurie suggested KKB purchase doggie bags to hand out. Kim will look into the cost of printed doggie bags.

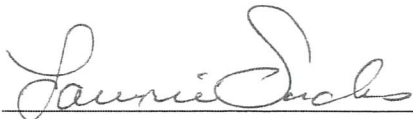
No decision made at this time will table until May meeting.
