I. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Pro Tem Kelly Turner called the meeting to order at 6:07 p.m.

Mayor Pro Tem Kelly Turner recognized Charles Overstreet for his five years of service with City Council and the Planning and Zoning Board.

City Secretary, Leslie Galloway administered the Oath of Office to Sandra Lee, for City Council, Place 3, for a two year term - 2017-2019.

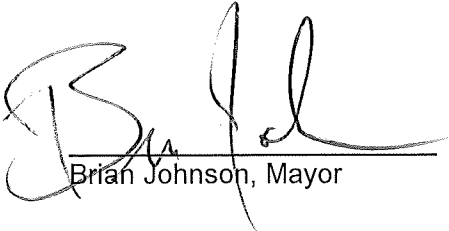
E. Oath of Office for Jan Joplin, City Council Place 5, 2017-2019 term
