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RESOLUTION NO. _____

**A FINAL RESOLUTION TO REMOVE CITY MANAGER; AND PROVIDING
AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the City of Kennedale (“**City**”) and George Campbell entered into an Employment Agreement on April 17, 2017, which was subsequently amended by an Amendment of Employment Agreement on December 17, 2019 (the Employment Agreement and Amendment of Employment Agreement are collectively referred to as the “**Agreement**”); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 4 of the Agreement, City may suspend or remove Mr. Campbell, but only if at least 30 days before the suspension or removal shall become effective, the City Council, by a vote of not less than four of its members, adopts a preliminary resolution stating the reasons for removal; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted a preliminary resolution in accordance with Section 4 of the Agreement on June 22, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this resolution is to serve as a final resolution of removal in accordance with Section 4 of the Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KENNEDALE, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1.

George Campbell is removed as City Manager.

SECTION 2.

The Agreement shall be deemed to terminate on the effective date of this resolution.

SECTION 3.

This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
