Motion to Approve: Councilmember Connor, **Second by:** Councilmember Degenhart. **Motion passed unanimously.**

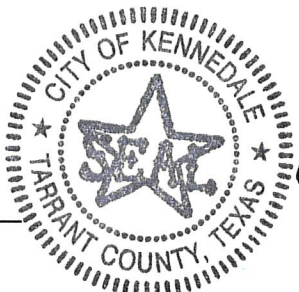
