KKB is considering changing the Adopt-a-Spot application to say the approved applicant can put the collected trash in their regular trash pick-up or or they may use City dumpsters on Village St. and the one located on City Hall's back parking lot. KKB will consider adopting the spot on Little School Rd. / Bluebird for Beautification to the City of Kennedale entrance sign. The members are considering ordering some "available " Adopt-a-Spot signs to put around the City so citizens know these spots are available to be adopted.

E. KKB volunteer report

KKB members have logged 66 volunteer hours for the month of January 2023.

Kim Courtney and Laurie Sanders took webinar training from Keep Texas Beautiful and a training class with Toni Moorhead, Tarrant Water District.

F. Coker garden update

Library Director Elizabeth Partridge is submitting a grant to create an outdoor learning and growing space outside the library in Town Center Park. It will be a place for growing flowers to attract wildlife, grow herbs and small veggies for the public to help with, an area for letting kids get in the dirt and plant things, and provide a space for all-ages education through local master gardeners and other interested/ capable parties. Ms. Partridge has not heard back from them, but it is early into the application process.

G. Windshield Survey results report.

KKB reported there is less litter in the city this year. There has been some illegal dumping of furniture and trash on North Rd. The Public Works Department has addressed this issue.
