II. WORK SESSION

A. WORK SESSION REPORTS

1. Use of EDC Property to create a food truck destination at Link St and W. Kennedale Parkway.

City Manager Darrell Hull stated that there's been some interest from food truck companies that are wanting to establish their business in Kennedale on some of our EDC-owned properties. One area of interest is off of Kennedale Pkwy & Link St.

2. Discuss the budget for the Home Town Christmas Event.

City Manager Darrell Hull stated that we would be looking at purchasing new lights for the event that we own and could change into many different colors. This expense would be between \$15,000-\$20,000. He would like to continue on with \$50,000 being in the budget for Hometown Christmas and that cost might even go down some once we have purchased the brand new lights. City Manager Hull would also like to move forward with purchasing a nativity scene for our Hometown Christmas event & TownCenter Park.
