



KEEP KENNEDALE BEAUTIFUL COMMISSION MINUTES
REGULAR MEETING | JUNE 13, 2023 AT 6:00 PM CITY HALL CONFERENCE ROOM | 405

I. CALL TO ORDER Chair Kim Courtney called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm.

II. WORK SESSION

A. WORK SESSION REPORTS

1. Review Adopt-a-spot Application:

The sign needs to read Darby Smith. Darby, Mother and dog will clean Timberline and Clover for one block. The sign needs to be placed where it faces the school.

2. Proposed dates for the Mayor's Monarch Pledge: September 9, 2023 (same day as bring it), September 16, 2023 (one week later), or August 5, 2023.

The Mayor's Pledge " The Butterfly Party" will be held on September 16, 2023, from 9:00 am to 11:00 am. The Mayor is working on sponsorships. Kim would like to have a butterfly tent that has live Monarch butterflies and Painter Ladies. The cost for the tent and butterflies is \$495.00 for two hours. Kim would like to purchase signs for advertising the event for \$300.00. KKB would also like to give 200 seed packets at 80 cents per packet, \$160.00 KKB plans to do a seed exchange, face painting and tattoos.

5. Storage unit for KKB Town Center Item.

Keith researched the different types and prices of the sheds available for KKB to purchase. His research concluded that the vinyl sheds at

\$1,500.00 were flimsy and would not last very long. The tuff sheds were more durable and would last longer, but they cost \$4,000.00. Keith feels the tuff shed is better value for the money and would be the best solution for KKB. Keith stated the shed could be ordered from Home Depot and it would be delivered already built. Kristian agreed with Keith and stated the Public Works department would level a spot and build a slab for the shed to sit.

6. Wildflower prairie cost and location.

Kim and Mayor Joplin have been discussing how KKB can incorporate wild flowers throughout the city in order to cut back on mowing. KKB would like to do a wild flower experiment in the city's four round bouts. They will plant Buffalo grass around the edge of the round a bout and wild flowers in the middle.

7. " Bring It " event planning.

Bring It will be on September 9, 2023. Kim asked Kenneth Michaels to be the head of the committee. Kenneth said he would speak to the City Manager about it.

2. Consider the approval of a budget for the KKB storage unit.

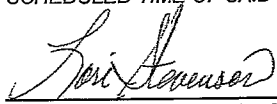
Keith made a motion to spend up to \$5,000.00 on the KKB storage unit.
