

PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD MINUTES

I. CALL TO ORDER

Pursuant to Texas Government Code §551.071, the Parks and Recreation Board reserves the right to adjourn into Executive (Closed) Session at any time during the meeting to seek legal advice from the City Attorney on any item posted on the agenda.

A. WORK SESSION REPORTS

1. Discuss a plan for fixing and updating the city parks.
Jeff went over the main priority for the parks, starting with Sonora. Replacing the playground equipment, an awning to shade the playground, wood chips for the flooring and replacing horse shoes with corn hole game. They would also like to have some solar lighting around the park for safety and a new lighted Sonora Park Sign.

Town Center Park will have all minor repairs to the playground fixed and the cars to be replaced. Wood Chips for the playground. A lighted Ralph Mooney sign for the pavilion, and a tarp with the City logo to be used at special events.

Rodgers Farm's basketball court needs restriping, and an additional basketball goal to make two half courts. Solar for the basketball court and lighting for the park for safety. An Awning to cover the playground. The playground equipment needs minor repairs. Wood chips for the flooring. The Rodgers Farm Park sign needs to be moved to the top of the hill and add lights to the sign.

Jeff concluded the board had completed the task that the Council asked of them within the allotted time. Kristian Sugrim will make a report to present to the Council.

The City Manager provided the plans to remodel the water fountain and the Veterans' memorial in Town Center Plaza.

Colby made the motion to approve the April 11, 2023 and the March 14, 2023 regular meeting minutes; Corey 2nd; Motion Carried.

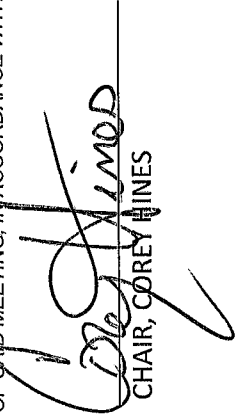

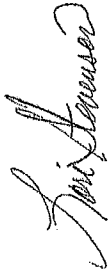
IV. ADJOURNMENT
