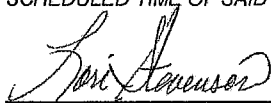
Keith made a motion to approve the Adopt-a-Spot application and the North Rd locations; Laurie 2nd; Motion passed Unanimously.

These are my notes for following up from last week's meeting.
Let me know if you have anything I have forgotten or that I owe to you.

1. The placement of the new adopt-a-spot signs should be on each end of North Road.
One, close to the intersection of North Road and Dick Price Road and the other close to the intersection of North Road and Averett/Broadway.
I can send a photo of a map if you need more information. ***A workorder has been generated***
2. Bring it! as an Annual Event
Please discuss with Darrell and determine what we can offer this year. It looks like there may be Crud Cruiser dates in October and November.
Crud Cruiser, Action shred, electronic disposal, clothes, everything we did in 2023. We would like to address and add tire and mattress disposal. We will need to get a date on the calendar soon.

“Bring It” is scheduled with the City of Fort Worth Environmental Collection Center for Saturday, September 7, 2024. Also, a discussion with the CM will ascertain funding

3. Waste Connection donation – please check to see if this stipend has been continued.
This is how we have paid for Bring it! in the past, traditionally these expenses were not journaled against the annual \$5,000 budget of KKB.

We believe this is incorrect. “Bring It” has always been paid for through the KKB fund. The City of Kennedale has never received a donation from Waste Connection. It’s our understanding the past Human Resources Director, Kelly Cooper, had set up a contract with Simple Recycling to Pick up recycle items for the Citizens of Kennedale. Based on the agreement with Simple Recycling, 1 cent per pound of recycled items was returned to the City; which at the time, the City was allowing this money to go into the KKB fund. However, this contract no longer exists. In 2020 (COVID) Simple Recycling was contacted by First Methodist Church in Kennedale. They promoted for the Citizens to bring all recyclable items to the First Methodist Church, and once the Church pick out what they wanted, then Simple Recycling would pick up directly from the Methodist Church.

4. Butterfly Garden Pathway installation,
Please discuss with Darrell and let us know how quickly this can be completed.

Based on a discussion with our CM, the existing pathway will be rehabilitated, very shortly. Similarly, a ramp will be installed to the KKB toolshed

5. Railroad Park rocks and asphalt piles at the corner of Averett/Broadway/North Road
Please determine if the Railroad will get this cleaned up – or if this is something the Parks Department will need to do.
This corner will be super difficult to mow until these items are removed.

Based on a recent meeting with UPRR staff, the asphalt will be removed; however, the rocks stays. It’s on UPRR easement, and are to be used for RR maintenance

6. Dumping at Railroad Park
Large items have been dumped behind the trees again as well as larger scale trash left from the road construction crew.
These trash items are too large for our new adopt a spot volunteers to pick up.

The area referenced is not a City Park. You need to report all illegal dumping to the Kennedale Police Department or Code Enforcement.

A work order has been submitted, and placed in the queue.

7. Dumping in the Valley Lane Commercial Areas – as reported in the Windshield Survey what can be done about this? Photos (not very good) attached.

All illegal dumping needs to be reported to the Kennedale Police Department. The third picture debris is on private property. You need to notify Code Enforcement.

A work order has been submitted and placed on the queue.

Not part of the discussion from the meeting:

Irrigation System in Town Center. Has the water system been turned on? ***Not at this time, we've had extensive amounts of rainfall; it will remain off until needed***

9. Can we get a financial report for Fiscal Year 2023? I would like to have before next month's meeting if possible. Having the breakdown of what was spent where would be helpful. ***A financial transaction report is attached; however, in the future, please submit an open records request. This can be done online from the City's website: www.cityofkennedale.com***
